



TUITION CONTRACT & REFUND POLICY

Buds & Blossoms

Thank you for your interest in our programs! Because our programs require a significant commitment of time and resources, we encourage you to read through the following policies prior to committing to a program:

1. Program Eligibility

As an intermediate-level program, students enrolling in Buds & Blossoms must have a basic understanding of herbal medicine through either a comprehensive introductory-level course or significant self-study to benefit from this course and not feel overwhelmed or confused by the content. Basic understanding should include familiarity with the language of herbal energetics (either Western, Ayurvedic or Chinese), herbal actions, and have knowledge of and personal experience with using various herbal preparations. 2. Certificate Eligibility

This is a certificate program, and to receive a certificate you must pass the class with a 70% or greater. You agree to make reasonable efforts to attend classes and to contact SGS when you cannot attend. While you are responsible for keeping up with assignments and class attendance, SGS reserves the sole right not to award any class certificate based on excessive class absenteeism, failure to keep up with program work, disruptive behavior in class (and/or to any fellow students) and any other reason where SGS, in its sole reasonable judgment, determines that you did not exemplify the knowledge, skills and/or conduct to certify that you possess such qualities in relation to your program course work. You acknowledge that the program is solely for personal educational knowledge and SGS makes no promises or guarantees to you concerning any matter related to the program that is not expressly stated in this letter agreement.

2. Refund Policy

Subsequent to SGS's receipt of your program payment in full, should you decide to withdraw from the program, you will be entitled to a refund as follows:

1. Students who withdraw from the 14 days of the first class from the program are eligible for a full refund, less the credit card processing fees incurred from the original transaction. To withdraw, you must email sacredgardenschool@gmail.com to inform us of your refund request in writing.
2. If you wish to withdraw after the first 14 days, but within the 6 weeks of the program, you may be eligible for a 75% refund and will lose all access to this course content.
3. If you withdraw at any point after October 1, you will not be entitled to any tuition refund, however, you may choose to retain access to the content on Teachable that you paid for and can join another round of this program in the future if you want to participate in the live portion for full credit.

Tuition refunds, if any, shall be sent to you no later than 14 days after the date of your withdrawal in writing to SGS, usually within 7-10 business days.

If you fail to meet any of your obligations under this Agreement, including the payment of any fees or costs, SGS shall have the right to withhold your certificate and remove your access to the program content upon 7 seven days prior written notice to you.
